Job Summary:

Reporting to the Implementation Officer the Socio-Econ Gap Surveyor will be tasked with conducting surveys to gather information for the Socio – Economic Gap project for TKC. All data collected will be provided to the Research Assistant for input and analysis. The position is Casual, meaning, as an employee in the public service, your employment is that of a casual nature to work for the specified period of time of 12 weeks, to contact participants and completion of surveys.

Working Conditions:

- The nature of the position requires full mobility to conduct on-site and in the field surveys within the Ta'an Traditional Territory
- Some participants may push back against some of the answers being sought and will test the interpersonal skills and attitudes of the Surveyor
- Surveyors will work in teams of 2 for safety purposes, so working collaboratively is required
- Position requires flexibility in working outside of core business hours
- Candidates with good relationships across the Ta'an community is better suited to this role

As per policy, preference will be given to those of Aboriginal Ancestry who self- declare in their cover letter and/or résumé.
