- **TKC OFFICE OPERATIONS CONTINUE SAFE-DISTANCING MEASURES DUE TO COVID-19**

As of December 1, all people in TKC buildings are required to wear a mask when in public areas such as hallways, kitchens, the boardroom, and when meeting with others. - **TKC'S LANDS & RESOURCES 2021 Event – January 29-30, Yukon Inn**

TKC Citizens are being invited to a special Lands and Resources event set for January 29-30, 2021 at the Yukon Inn in Whitehorse. This event will give TKC Citizens an opportunity to meet with staff, learn about the department's projects and initiatives and offer feedback and direction. It will showcase Lands & Resources projects including salmon restoration and planning initiatives, caribou management and Settlement Land remediation, as well as provide Citizens updates on Land Use Planning (LUP) projects and Geographic Information System (GIS) and mapping progress. This will be a walk-through style event, organized to accommodate social distancing. Citizens will visit booths to have one-on-one conversations with staff. The department is also arranging for Citizens to receive an update via telephone. An online survey (paper version will be available) is also being planned so the department can receive Citizen

feedback. There will be draws for door prizes for all participants, whether attending in person, via telephone or by completing the online survey.
