## Notice Call for Expression of Interest

### Alternate Member of Council, Laberge Renewable Resource Council

Ta'an Kwäch'än Council is inviting interested Citizens to submit their letter of interest to be reviewed and nominated by Ta'an Kwäch'än Council, Chief and Council, to become an alternate member of the Laberge Renewable Resources Council.

#### Background

As outlined in Chapter 16 of the *Ta'an Kwäch'än Council Final Agreement*, a renewable resource council is established as a primary instrument for local renewable resource management in the Traditional Territory of the Ta'an Kwäch'än Council (TKC). TKC is currently looking to fill one vacancy for an alternate member to sit on the Laberge Renewable Resource Council (LRRC) for the remainder of the 5-year term (ending July 21, 2025). As an alternate member of the LRRC, you would be expected to attend monthly meetings, as well as the Annual General Assembly and working group meetings. In the case where the full-time member is unavailable to attend a meeting, the alternate would take their place if any voting is required. As a member of the council, you would get paid an honorarium when you attend any meetings or workshops.

Each renewable resource council is set up to act in the public interest and consistent with Chapter 16 of the Umbrella Final Agreement, they may make recommendations to the Minister, the affected Yukon First Nation, the Board and the Sub-Committee on any matter related to conservation of fish and wildlife.

#### Requirements

All nominees to the LRRC are required to have resided within the Traditional Territory of the Ta'an Kwäch'än Council for at least one year immediately prior to their appointment and shall have long term familiarity with renewable resources in the Traditional Territory of the Ta'an Kwäch'än Council.

#### Nomination Process

Interested persons are requested to submit a letter of interest outlining their qualifications (template available upon request). A list of persons meeting the requirements will be submitted to Chief and Council for a decision. As outlined in Chapter 16.6.4, once Chief and Council have selected their nominee, the name will be sent to the Minister of Environment for acceptance. Letters of interest should be sent by **4:30 PM February 19, 2021 to:**
