**Re Behaviour of Maggie Broeren family members at GA and TKC meetings**

---

The Ta'an Kwäch'än Judicial Council (TKJC) has received your letter of February 18, 2016 where in you state that members of the Maggie Broeren family "...have made it their mission to disrupt and cause confusion" at TK meetings, the GA and TKC meetings.

Under the Constitution the TKJC has authority limited to:

- Adjudication of cases of alleged violations of the laws;
- Mediation or arbitration of disputes between citizens and the TKC where parties agree;
- Investigation of financial irregularities of the TKC;
- Determination of the validity of a law or regulation; and
- Removal of a member of the TKC if found to be compromising dignity or effectiveness of that office.


The TKJC cannot accept jurisdiction on matters related to the behaviour of citizens at meetings or the General Assembly. If you have a complaint against a specific person who is a member of the TKC, you may refile a complaint naming the person and describing your reasons for the complaint which would clarify under which authority (as noted above) you believe the TKJC has jurisdiction to proceed.

If you file a complaint it must be served (a copy delivered) to that person, which can be facilitated through the TK office.

In the event the TKJC does not receive clarification (as noted above) before March 25, 2016, we will consider this complaint abandoned by you.
