# 7.1.3.3 Living Allowance Rates

Section: Student Support

Students approved for full-time study are entitled to living allowances during the months they are attending school.

Living allowance categories have been established as:

- 1. Single Student Living at home, and
- 2. Student living on their own.

Students with dependents will receive an additional amount for each dependent. In certain circumstances, a spouse or common-law partner may be considered as a dependent. This will require supporting documentation.

Students who work while studying full-time are not eligible to receive living allowances if their individual annual income exceeds \$35,000 or their family income exceeds \$75,000. Students must self-declare this in their application. Failure to do so may disqualify them for support under the Post-Secondary Student Support Program Policy. TKC Education may, at any time request verification of income. Exceptions may be made if financial need can be demonstrated. These situations will be reviewed by the TKC Education Commission and their decision is final.

Living Allowance Rates are identified in Appendix One of this policy. These rates will be adjusted annually in accordance with the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) established for TKC. Annual increases will come into effect on April 1<sup>st</sup>, after the TKC annual operating budget has been approved by Chief and Council.

Chief and Council reserve the right to withhold COLA adjustments in any given fiscal year, if necessary.
