

## Call for Expressions of Interest Facilitator for Community Consultation for the Ta'an Kwäch'än Council Lands Act

The Ta'an Kwäch'än Council (TKC) is seeking a facilitator to assist with the development of a citizen led Public Consultation process for the development of the TKC Lands Act.

The TKC Lands, Resources and Heritage (LRH) department will be hosting a series of Public Consultation events over the course of the next few months. The Facilitator will work with LRH and TKC Citizens to develop a vision that will assist TKC in developing and enacting a TKC Lands Act.

The Facilitator:

- Will have a familiarity with the land use issues and Yukon First Nations;
- Will be creative in designing workshops and/or breakout sessions;
- Has experience working with a diverse audience including Political appointees, Elder's, Youth, and members of the community;

Tasks include:

- Compiling community comments from previous consultations and including them into the current process;
- Assisting LRH in designing unconventional methods of public outreach; presenting and explaining high level documents and/or legal terminology in laymen's terms;
- Design and produce informational outreach materials that will be distributed throughout the community;
- Working with the Project Lead and the community to draft a Communication Strategy specific to citizen outreach and inclusion throughout the process.
