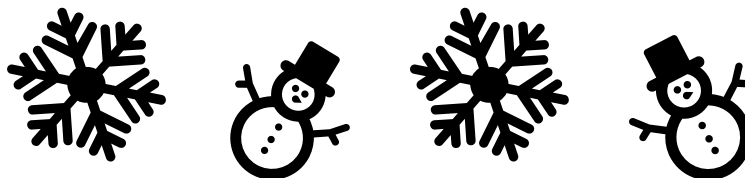
On Going Events!
