The Adäka Cultural Festival will present the **Ta'an Kwäch'än Dancers** at the Kwanlin Dun Cultural Center on **Sunday, June 30**<sup>th</sup> **at 2:45 pm**, and then on **Thursday, July 4**<sup>th</sup> **at 7:00 pm** as part of the Indigenous Language and Song Celebration Gala! Come out and support our dancers and cheer on the hard work they have been putting into the regalia and songs! The Adäka Cultural Festival, whose name means 'coming into the light' in the Southern Tutchone language, shines a light on the arts and culture of Yukon First Nations. The festival, now in its ninth year, also welcomes Indigenous artists from around the world.
