• K-12 EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT

The <u>K-12 Educational Support Applications</u> are now available on the TKC website at <u>www.taan.ca</u> or pick an application up at the office. TKC provides the following supports for all youth citizens attending K-12 in Yukon Schools:

- School Supplies Subsidy: All students are eligible to receive \$200 dollars to help cover the cost of school supplies. (Cheque issued upon completion of application form.)
- Attendance Awards: All students who choose to enroll in the TKC "Steps to Success" attendance initiative
 are eligible to receive prizes and certificates rewarding consistent school attendance.
- Tutoring: All students are eligible for free individual tutoring provided by professional tutors. Lunch time tutoring is available at certain Whitehorse schools.
- Bus Passes: Monthly bus passes are available to students for extracurricular activities, if they do not
 already receive one from the Department of Education.
