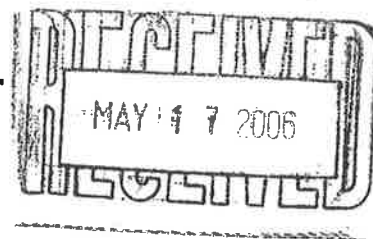

**Re Challenge to the Validity and Certain Provisions**

This will confirm that your letter dated April 15, 2006, respecting the above-noted matter, was received by the Judicial Council on April 18, 2006.

Section 4.4 of the Ta'an Kwäch'än Council Constitution states, in part:

“...The process for challenging the validity of laws and regulations shall be made in accordance with section 14.0 of this Constitution.”

While your letter refers to the challenge being made under the Constitution, including section 4.4, there is no indication that the process required by 14.0 of the Constitution has been followed, nor is there any indication that the procedural requirements in 11.0 of the Judicial Council Rules of Procedure have been followed. As a result, we are not able to accept your letter of April 15 as being proper or sufficient written notice to the Judicial Council under 14.0 of the Constitution. If you decide to proceed with a challenge under 14.0 of the Constitution we would ask that you resubmit your materials having regard to the requirements of section 14.0 of the Constitution and 11.0 of the Rules of Procedure.

If your challenge is not being made pursuant to section 14.0 of the Constitution, please specify in your materials the applicable law under which you are making the challenge and the basis of the Judicial Council's legal authority for considering the matter.
