#### UPCOMING BY-ELECTION FOR DEPUTY CHIEF

Ta'an Kwäch'än Council will be meeting in early July to issue a writ and select a date for a byelection for a new Deputy Chief. According to the *Elections Act* section 9.1. "A date for a byelection shall be declared by the Council within thirty days of the office for Chief or Deputy Chief becoming vacant in accordance with section 8.13 of the *Constitution*." Christina Peters resigned her position as Deputy Chief of Ta'an Kwäch'än Council effective June 7, 2022. TKC will keep Citizens informed of the process as dates are confirmed.

TKC's Lands & Resources have installed Lindgren traps to capture and identify beetle species. This project is in partnership with Yukon Government's Forestry Branch.
