This position requires a high level of physical work in remote settings in all weather conditions, traveling the backcountry by truck, ATV, snowmobile, and on foot. You will monitor both wildlife and human activity (includes interaction with people on the land) and make oral and written reports. You are expected to be available for flexible and erratic work hours of up to 7 hours per day. This may include evenings and weekends.

- Minimum Grade 12 or the equivalent in education, training, and experience.
- Knowledge of the history, cultures, Traditional Territory, goals, and aspirations of the Ta'an Kwäch'än Council.
- Understanding of the goals and objectives of the Lands and Resources department and specifically the Natural Resources Branch.
- Knowledge of TKC Final Land Claims Agreements, Self-government, Implementation and Strategic Plans.
- Experience in back country travel.
- Ability to interact with people, particularly hunters and recreational groups, with tactful, productive skill.

Specific Skills:

- Physical fitness and ability to spend extended patrol days in the field.
- Wilderness First Aid Certificate or willingness to obtain, immediately.
- Valid class 5 driver's licence.
- Knowledge and experience with First Nations culture.
- Must take safety instruction certification course for outdoor travel.

Equipment Skills:

- Ability to operate a computer (e-mail, word processing, spreadsheet, database), telephone, fax, photocopier, calculator.
- Ability to operate, off road vehicles, snowmobiles, boat and motor and 4x4 truck.
