



Southern Lakes Salmon Plan

The Governments of TKC, KDFN and C/TFN are working together to develop a community-based salmon plan to connect people, culture and traditions around salmon in the Southern Lakes region. Dennis Zimmerman of Big Fish Little Fish Consultants is the facilitator for this project, with funding from the Yukon River Panel Restoration and Enhancement Fund. This Salmon Plan will be driven by the values and priorities of citizens and their respective governments and will

feature an implementation plan. It will also reflect the holistic nature of salmon and their connection to habitat, people and cultures.

This collaborative project began in 2019, and our first citizen engagement event took place in February 2020, which had several TKC citizens in attendance. Unfortunately, due to Covid-19, we have not been able to host another engagement event since then, but our team is still working hard with what we currently have to create a draft plan. We hope to share this draft with citizens in 2021, once it is safe to do so, and get more feedback at that time.
